Superintendent's Report - Angus Wilson

- Ministry moved FSA date to middle of March
- Black Shirt Day is January 15th to be supported at schools, but with little leadtime not a lot of organized activities possible this year.
- HMS had a COVID-19 cluster before Christmas
- New COVID-19 exposure at Hatzic Elementary
- Mental health in schools overall attendance is improved this year. Suicide risk assessment numbers have increased, a number in elementary school, which is very concerning and school district is aware.
- Unexpected death of a teachers affected the district greatly. Flight Team deployed
- Summit letters have been sent to students not actively submitting. If curricular work is not being submitted, seats will not be held within district schools.
- Board Strategic planning coming up including bus routes and catchment area review
